Dear Children's Academy Community,

As we approach the 15th anniversary of Children's Academy's founding, we celebrate the many milestones our school has achieved:

- We graduated our first class of high school seniors in 2022;
- We have grown enrollment from 2 students in 2009 to 59 students this school year;
- We relocated and expanded from our original 7,965 square foot space to our beautiful 15,000 square foot home on East 50th Street; and
- We installed Cheval Bryant as our brilliant Head of School

Now seeking to build on our successes, we look ahead with purpose. In June 2023, we launched a strategic planning process aimed at charting our course for the next 3-5 years. We engaged faculty, staff, trustees, and parents in a dialogue to determine what we value most about Children's Academy, as well as where we see possibilities for change. The Task Force analyzed data, identified strategic challenges and opportunities, explored internal and external influences and trends, and drafted a framework of key priorities, goals, and strategies. To guide our planning process, the school's leadership engaged Educators Collaborative, a nationally recognized firm that assisted with the Head of School search in 2021 and knows Children's Academy well. A Task Force composed of trustees, parents, and senior administrators worked collaboratively through a series of exercises designed to establish priorities based on trends, data, and feedback from our community.

Meeting throughout the summer, the Task Force crafted Strategic Goals, Strategies, and Work Plans with action steps. Estimated costs, metrics of success, and responsibility for implementation are in development, as Children's Academy moves forward on the execution of the strategic plan.

- Develop an updated and data-driven picture of our student diagnoses and learning profiles
- Gather demographic statistics to gain deeper knowledge of our community, including current and alumni students, faculty, and staff
- Utilize data to create updated promotional materials to increase understanding in the larger community about Children's Academy
- Deepen the understanding of the Children's Academy model and student profile for all faculty and staff, further equipping them to work in close partnership

Strategic Goal

Providing an academically robust and emotionally supportive learning experience is at the heart of our work at Children's Academy. We intend to strengthen our unique program to better meet the needs of students and families, integrating data collection, student outcome assessments, curriculum development, and reviewing the balance of academic rigor and therapeutic support.

- Utilize assessments to review student performance and determine student outcomes each year
- Leverage student data to evaluate the overall effectiveness of the academic program
- Use approved curriculums in conjunction with the scope and sequence, modifying as needed to meet individual student needs
- Work in partnership with parents to address areas of concern and determine if additional support is needed and available
- Strengthen integration of therapeutic supports into instructional practices
- Explore ways to further incorporate technology as a learning tool and for relevant skill development

Program excellence and strong relationships between students and teachers are paramount to a child's educational success at Children's Academy. We will strive to invest in recruiting and retaining faculty and staff who are highly skilled, passionate about our mission, and dedicated to the success of every child.

- Develop and implement a more robust recruiting plan for faculty and staff
- Continue to foster a culture of professional development for individual staff growth and schoolwide learning to support cross-disciplinary engagement
- Provide faculty streamlined processes and tools that support greater efficiency
- Showcase and build on the professional expertise at Children's Academy to promote ongoing growth and advancement
- Nurture faculty and staff connections with one another and the Children's Academy mission
- Foster a "people first" supportive culture that centers health and wellness for faculty and staff

Strategic Goal

We aim to secure and develop additional learning spaces that support program excellence, student safety and well being, continued enrollment growth, student retention, and opportunities to build community among students, faculty, and staff.

- Assemble an internal working group to determine the current/future spatial needs of the Children's Academy

- Periodically re-evaluate the security profile of the current facility and update the response plans for unanticipated or emergency situations.

- Develop and implement a practice of regularly evaluating staffing needs and compensation to ensure Children's Academy remains competitive in recruiting and retaining high quality faculty and staff

Strategic Goal

Approaching its 15th anniversary, Children's Academy is flourishing and poised for continued growth. Crucial to its future success is the ongoing cultivation of a strong, diverse, and sustainably structured Board that leverages institutional knowledge and governance best practices to set the strategic and fiscal direction of the school and support the delivery of its mission.
